What to expect?

This working group will define the pedagogical continuity between our various preparatory activities. How many people?

Unit support

Wat to expect?

We expect you to reinforce a unit leading team.

Expectation: During the preliminary phase of the European Jamboree project, you will join a Unit as additional leader and thus participate in the full preparation of the weekends. You can fall back on the CMT Unit team to get support in your missions. You will also be responsible for evaluation and feedback of activities.

You will also be responsible to make the link between the IST of the unit and organise their help to the unit's life.

Which specific knowledge/skills are required?

- ▶ You have experience in leaders support.
- ▶ You can guide, communicate, listen.
- ▶ Organisational talent
- ▶ You are flexible and easily accessible

How much time will this take?

- ▶ 2 Unit weekends
- ▶ 4-5 meetings with the leaders' team of your unit

How many people?

5 IST (1 per Unit):

- ▶ 2 IST for Units NL
- ▶ 1 IST for Unit FR
- ▶ 2 IST for bilingual Units

Communication

1. Photographers

What is it all about?

What to expect?

Which specific knowledge/skills is required?

- ▶ Able to edit photos
- ▶ Have knowledge of how your camera works.
- ▶ Able to make good pictures, so we can keep on using them for the next jamboree (promotion).
- ▶ Lightroom & Photoshop are a plus.

How much time will this take?

- ▶ As a photographer you'll see a lot of activities during the weekend, because you'll be photographing them. Probably you'll be editing your pictures later on in the day/evening.
- ▶ 2 hours a month extra work from home.

How many people?

- ▶ At least 2 IST.

2. Social media manager(s)

What is it all about?

Do you have a creative mind? Do you like to think of some new stuff to post on social media? Are you familiar with different social media and their specificities; facebook, instagram, youtube,..? Then you are our guy/girl!

What to expect?

- ▶ You'll think of some creative ways to keep our social media up to date.
- ▶ You'll post every week on our social media.
- ▶ You will use the pictures the photographers make on the different weekends.
- ▶ You have the freedom to think, create and experiment with the social media.

Which specific knowledge/skills is required?

- ▶ Have a good pen, because you need to write and think of some nice text on social media.
- ▶ Speak Dutch or French. Both is a plus. (We do have translators)
- ▶ Have knowledge of social media (business platforms)

How much time will this take?

- ▶ 1 hour a week or 4 hours a month.
- ▶ You'll be working for the comm team during the different weekends and precamp. Possibly you'll be working for the comm team on jamboree as well.

How many people?

At least 2 persons (IST or leaders).

3. Copywriter / translator

What to expect?

As a copywriter you will write some text for the website, blog, or newsletter or social media. Together with the social media manager, you'll be thinking of some nice texts. Think of good ideas to bring out to our contingent.

Which specific knowledge/skills is required?

- ▶ You should be able to write a good text in French or Dutch. If you can write both, that's a plus.
- ▶ Have a good pen, because you need to write and think of some nice text on social media.
- ▶ Speak Dutch or French. Both is a plus. (We do have translators)
- ▶ If you can translate that's a plus.

How much time will this take?

- ▶ 1 hour a week or 4 hours a month.
- ▶ You'll be working from home to prepare our texts for the newsletter, website, blog,..
- ▶ During the weekends and precamp you'll be working for the comm team.

How many people?

At least 2 persons (IST or leaders): 1FR + 1NL.

4. Graphic designer

What to expect?

- ▶ You will design and create some nice things for social media, website or newsletter.
- ▶ You'll work together with the social media manager and copywriter.

Which specific knowledge/skills is required?

- ▶ Have a feeling with what's great graphic design.
- ▶ Be able to use programs like: illustrator, inDesign, Photoshop

How much time will this take?

- ▶ 1 hour a week or 4 hours a month

How many people?

2 persons (IST or leaders).
